Council Approves Ordinance Amending Sign Regulations at The Shops at Highland Village

At the June 12 meeting, Council held a public hearing and approved the first read of an ordinance amending the sign regulations at The Shops at Highland Village. The amendment would allow tenant monument signs and light pole banner signs. The second read of the ordinance will be considered at the June 26 meeting.

Council also approved the extension of the termination date of the City's Juvenile Curfew Regulations to June 30, 2021. The juvenile curfew hours are between 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights, and between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Sunday through Thursday. The ordinance applies to juveniles 16 years of age and under, and allows for several defenses, such as traveling on a direct route to or from a place of employment, emergency errand, etc. The Juvenile Curfew Ordinance, first enacted in 1995, is an effective tool in the protection of minors and the public, preventing juveniles from becoming crime victims, preventing illegal drug and alcohol abuse and discouraging other juvenile criminal activities.

The ceremonial swearing in of newly elected Council members took place at this meeting. Mayor Charlotte Wilcox and Council members Jon Kixmiller and Robert Fiester were sworn in at this meeting. Council member Fred Busche was elected Mayor Pro Tem and Barbara Fleming was elected Deputy Mayor Pro Tem.

In the City Manager Report the [HVTV Update](#) informed residents of the Eye on Highland Village app used to report areas in need of City attention and the Foodie Friday segment showcased the Rock 'N Ice House.
