Council Sets 2019 Legislative Program for the 86th Legislative Session

On January 22, City Council approved a resolution establishing the City's legislative policy which addresses issues and concerns impacting the City that may be addressed during the 2019 legislative session. The common theme to the program is Highland Village's belief that cities are the level of government most connected to, and thus most accountable to, the people they serve; as a result, the state should recognize and preserve local authority and support cities in their mission of providing quality local services to all Texans.

During the Mayor and Council Reports, Public Works Street and Code Manager Donald Strange was recognized for earning the Certified Public Works Professional Manager designation from the American Public Works Association (APWA). Mr. Strange is among the first 37 candidates to complete the certification program which began in August 2018. Mr. Strange began his career in public works with the City of Carrollton in 1985. He has been with the City of Highland Village since 2015.
