Council Continues Budget Discussions

At the July 27 meeting, Council continued FY 2021-22 Budget discussion with a presentation from staff on Special Revenue Funds. Further budget discussions will take place through July and August.

Council denied without prejudice a request for a Conditional Use Permit to allow a drive-thru business to be located at The Marketplace at Highland Village. The current Planned Development Ordinance for the Marketplace allows for five drive-thru uses with approval of a conditional use permit required for any additional drive-thru uses. A public hearing was held and Council denied the request without prejudice directing the developer to look at alternate options to bring before Planning & Zoning Commission and Council. The development is located at 2150 Village Parkway.

During the Mayor and Council Reports a swearing in ceremony was held for Officer Jonathan Jamieson. Council also recognized the Mayor for the Day, Annie Netsch, who is a student at McAuliffe Elementary and received the opportunity to be Mayor for the Day as part of the McAuliffe Chili Cook Off Auction.

During the City Manager and Staff Reports, the 2020 Nonprofit of the Year video was shown. This year's winner is [Cloud 9 Charities](#). [Children's Advocacy Center](#) and [Single Parent Advocate](#) were finalists for this year's award. The recognition is part of the annual Unity luncheon held as a joint event with the Highland Village Business Association, the Flower Mound Chamber of Commerce, and the Lewisville Area Chamber of Commerce. The Unity luncheon is an expo event for local nonprofit organizations and selects the Nonprofit of the Year based on the applications submitted by the organizations. Independent Financial has sponsored this event for the last 15 years. The Cross Timbers, Highland Village, Lewisville Morning, and Lewisville Noon Rotary Clubs also serve as sponsors and the selection committee.
