Council Continues Budget Discussion

At the July 25 meeting, Council continued FY 2023-24 Budget discussion with a presentation from staff on Special Revenue Funds. Further budget discussions will take place through August and September.

Council received a presentation and considered a resolution to authorize a contract for construction services of a First Responders Monument at the Municipal Complex. The contract included installation of the monument, lighting, landscaping and new site amenities as well as modification of the existing Veterans Monument site to allow for expansion. City Council did not approve the resolution by a vote of 1-6.

During the Mayor and Council Reports, a swearing in ceremony was held for Officer Todd Spillman.

During the City Manager and Staff Reports, City Manager Paul Stevens reminded residents interested in applying for a Council appointed board or commission to submit their application by July 31. The 2022 Nonprofit of the Year video was shown. [Lovepacs Lewisville](#) was selected as the 2022 Nonprofit of the Year at a joint Highland Village Business Association and Flower Mound and Lewisville Area Chambers of Commerce luncheon.
