

Welcome to Unity Dog Park!

Dog Park Rules

- Park hours are 6:00 A.M. - 11 P.M. The park is closed on Thursdays for routine maintenance and after heavy rain events. Please refer to the City web site for open/closure status.
- The off leash area will close without prior notice when wet, icy, hazardous conditions exist, or when maintenance needs are necessary. Gates will be locked during these times.
- Park gates must be CLOSED and LATCHED at all times.
- No person nine (9) years of age or younger allowed in dog park area; children between ten (10) and fifteen (15) years of age must be under adult supervision at all times while within the dog park. No running or chasing dogs allowed at any time.
- Dogs must be at least 4 months of age to enter the park.
- Dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the park and off leash while inside the park.
- Owner must remain within the dog park with their dog and have dog within view and under voice control at all times.
- No animals other than dogs are allowed.
- Maximum of two (2) dogs per owner.
- Aggressive dogs are prohibited. Dogs showing aggression toward people or other animals must be removed immediately.
- Owners are responsible for pick-up and disposal of pet waste inside and outside of the dog park and properly disposing in receptacles provided.
- Dogs that are in heat, aggressive, or sick are not allowed.
- All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations.
- No digging; Owner must repair any damage caused by their dog.
- No food or treats for dogs or humans allowed.
- No spiked, prong, choke or pinch collars allowed on dogs within the dog park.
- No carriages, bicycles, skate boards, scooters, skates, roller blades, sport activities, children's toys or any motorized vehicles allowed, unless necessary by reason of handicap or disability.
- No commercial activities, solicitation of business or grooming allowed.
- This park is designated for dogs and their owners. You will encounter dogs off leash. Park users and dog owners assume all risks related to the off leash area and park use. The City of Highland Village shall not be liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog in the park. Dog owners are legally and financially responsible for their dog's behavior.
- All other general park rules and city ordinances must be obeyed.
